DECISION NO. 11

**IN REFERENCE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TECHNICAL ASSISTANT
OF THE SECRETARIAT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS**

Pursuant to paragraph 2(a) of the Understanding Regarding the Establishment of a Secretariat for Environmental Matters Under the Dominican Republic-Central America-United States Free Trade Agreement (CAFTA-DR) and Article 4.3 of the Agreement Establishing a Secretariat for Environmental Matters Under the Dominican Republic-Central America- United States Free Trade Agreement (Secretariat Agreement), the Environmental Affairs Council established under Article 17.5.1 of the CAFTA-DR,

DECIDES:

To reappoint Mr. Mario René Mancilla Barillas of Guatemala to serve as the Technical Assistant of the Secretariat for Environmental Matters for an additional two-year term, starting on February 1, 2013, ending on February 1, 2015, with an opportunity to be appointed for successive terms if the Council so decides.

Pursuant to Article 4.3 of the Secretariat Agreement, the Council may, at any moment, decide to remove the Technical Assistant for cause or other appropriate reason.
